Year 7, 8 and 9: Covid-19 – Academy Closure

You will have heard the news last night that, from Friday of this week (for the vast majority of students), schools will be closed until further notice. We want to reassure you that it is only the school building that is closed and that we will continue to provide resources and structure for learning via the academy website. More information will be provided as it becomes available, but we aim to have resources available for students to start using online from Monday next week.
