Dear families

For the second year running at the end of the year at Dixons Cottingley, students will present an account of their progress over the year to their Dream Team. This consists of their family, form tutor, and any other key adult within the academy. Throughout this cycle students will be working hard on preparing their presentations, which they will deliver to you and their form tutor for five minutes. This self-report is an essential aspect of feedback for your child's progress and integral to their excellent outcomes.

This event is to be a highlight of the school year. It allows the students to reflect on everything they have learnt, on how they have demonstrated the school values, how they have met our learning habits and their academic successes and next steps to support students to climb their mountain.
