### GCSE Intervention and Revision Sessions

An integral part of Year 11 for our students is attending intervention sessions, which take place after school. These sessions will help them gain the maximum grades possible in their GCSE examinations, which take place in Summer 2024. Subject specific staff will be available each day, after school, to deliver tailored revision that is based on gaps in students' knowledge and will support them achieving exceptional results.

Some of these sessions will be **compulsory**, whilst other sessions are **optional**.

Intervention will take place on the following nights.

#### Compulsory sessions: targeted small group intervention delivered after school – 1 hour

Selection for compulsory sessions has been based on your child's November mocks. If they have been selected for compulsory intervention, they must attend as they are at risk of not achieving their potential. This will likely impact their successful entry at college or other higher education establishment.

#### Optional revision delivered after school – 1 hour

These sessions are for any students who have not been specifically invited to intervention but wish to have additional support. These sessions will be exam practise based and will only apply to English, Maths and Science.

#### Corrections

If your child receives a correction on the same day that they have intervention, then the correction is the priority, and they must sit the correction rather than attend intervention to ensure they have a fresh start the next day.

Your child has been given their personalised timetable which outlines any compulsory sessions they are required to attend. Students can attend any of the other optional subjects if they do not have an allocated compulsory session on that day.

We want to all our students to achieve the best possible results and we know that excellent attendance, behaviour, homework, and attendance to these sessions will support this.
