GCSE Intervention and Revision Sessions

I hope you and your families have had an enjoyable break. Before the holiday we provided your child with their mock examination results. We are now in the final approach to the summer examinations and want to further support your child to achieve exceptional results when they sit their GCSEs.

As part of this programme of support, we have planned a series of intervention sessions, after school, for your child to attend. Some students will be expected to attend **compulsory** sessions whilst other sessions are **optional**.

Intervention will take place for students on the following nights.

There are two types of session that your child may be invited to:

Targeted small group intervention delivered after school – 1 hour

Specific students will be invited and their attendance will be monitored and followed up. Work in these sessions will be very targeted towards specific outcomes and the topics covered will be driven by QLAs from the mock exams.

Optional revision delivered after school – 1 hour

These sessions are for any students who have not been specifically invited to intervention, who wish to have additional support. These sessions will be exam practise based. These sessions will only apply to English, Maths and Science.

Today your child has been given their personalised timetable, which outlines any compulsory sessions they are required to attend. Students can attend any of the other optional subjects if they do not have an allocated compulsory session on that day.

Rewards

We want all our students to achieve the best possible results and we know that excellent attendance, behaviour, homework and attendance will support this. Today we have launched a reward scheme for students where they will receive points for the following areas:

- Intervention per session attended 5 points
- 1 week 100% attendance 10 points
- 1 week 100% homework 10 points
- 1 week 100% no behaviour corrections 10 points

These points will be accumulated by your child between now and the Easter break. The points can then be redeemed by your child for the following free rewards, based on the number of points achieved.

- Hoodie first 200 points
- Prom ticket second 150 points (total of 350)
- Surprise Trip ticket any student with more than 450 points



All students have the opportunity to achieve all of these rewards for free, if they consistently display our learning habits, attend school and attend our intervention sessions. We hope you will support your child to attend.
